NOTICE OF RACE

- **RULES:** The Racing Rules of Sailing and the rules of the Chesapeake Bay Log Canoe Association will govern the race.
- **ENTRIES:** Register online at [Regatta Network](http://RegattaNetwork.com) or the RockHallYachtClub.org website, or at the committee boat in the vicinity of buoy GR "LC" near the mouth of Langford Creek. There is a \$40 entry fee per boat for this regatta.
- **NOTICES TO COMPETITORS:** There will be no official regatta notice board. Changes to Sailing Instructions will be given verbally, or by flags, or signage from the committee boat.
- **COMMITTEE BOAT:** RHYC Race Committee, **Radio Channel 71.**
- **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing Instructions will be given to all yachts or their support boats from the committee boat.
- **SIGNAL MADE ASHORE:** All signals will be made from the Committee Boat, none being made ashore.
- **SCHEDULE OF RACES:** 3 races, Saturday and Sunday
